Make Your Own Tenugui

Tenugui are Japanese hand towels used for some of the dances. Sometimes it's wrapped around the head although its usually slung around the neck.

Preparation

- Parents cut any kind of cotton fabric so it is 35cm x 90 cm (13.75 in x 35.4 in)
- Fabric pens or tie-die ink
- Have samples or photos of "tenugui"

Steps

- 1. Design what the Tenugui should look like.
- Use fabric pens to decorate the tenugui OR use tie die ink to put patterns onto the tenugui.
- 3. Let dry overnight (or per instructions on the paint used).
- 4. Fold and iron
