Make Your own Sensu

Sensu are folding fans originally invented in Japan. They were highly prized by the courts in Imperial China and even in Europe.

Materials

- 12x12 sheet of scrapbook paper
- Raffia Ribbon
- Beads (optional)

Preparation

 Optionally, measure out and score the paper to make the folding easier.

Steps

- 1. Fold scrapbook paper like an accordion. Each fold about ½ inch wide.
- 2. Fold the whole thing into half.
- 3. Put glue on the "inside" parts and bring the halves together.
- 4. Tie the raffia ribbon at the bottom portion leaving a few inches of the ribbon to string a few beads for decoration, Secure the beads with a knot.
